The DHS Bus Service

Derby High operate six buses across Derbyshire and Staffordshire, which provide convenient and safe transport to and from school. Route 1 and route 4 pick-up and drop off outside school on Pastures Hill. All other routes use the large bus lay-by on Hillsway. School buses are available for Year 5 pupils and above. Younger children may travel on the bus if accompanied by older siblings. We ask that older students collect their younger siblings from the Junior or Infant School and accompany them to the bus.

At the end of the school day, buses depart from school at approximately 3.55pm. We ask students to make their way to the bus as soon as possible once school has finished to avoid delays. Each bus has the route number displayed in the front window. If a pupil misses their bus, they must inform a member of staff at Student Reception immediately.

To ease the worry of the first initial bus journeys from school a 'bus buddy' can be arranged. Please contact us to request a bus buddy or email your request to buses@derbyhigh.derby.sch.uk.

Glovers/Masons Coaches are contracted by school to operate the school bus service. They have confirmed that seatbelts are fitted in all vehicles and all of their drivers hold enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) certificates. As per the school bus travel code of conduct, all passengers must remain seated and wear seatbelts at all times.

Out of school hours (8.00am to 5.30pm) Glovers/Mason Coaches can be contact on 07976 525810. This number should only be used for genuine emergencies i.e. if the bus has failed to arrive at a stop etc. Please do not use this number to inform of late arrivals to the bus stop or sickness of children. If your child is ill or will not be travelling on the bus on a particular day/journey, please use the Kura app to cancel you journey, which will notify the driver of the change.

Times printed on the timetable are accurate (weather, road and traffic conditions permitting). Times stated on the timetable are the times the bus departs from each stop. We advise pupils to arrive at their pick-up point at least five minutes before the timetabled departure time.

Derby High School reserves the right to vary times and pick-up points due to changing needs. Prior notice will be given to parents of pupils affected.

In the event of bad weather Derby High School will keep parents informed if buses are unable to operate, are required to depart from school early or if they are delayed on the return journey home.

If there is demand for bus routes serving communities not currently on the timetable, we would be happy to consider implementing them. Please contact April Dunicliffe-Smith to discuss your requirements further – adunicliffe-smith@derbyhigh.derby.sch.uk

The school gives its advice on journey times in good faith. However, as a result of breakdown or traffic congestion, or other events beyond the reasonable control of the school and bus operator, journeys may take longer than predicted and in those circumstances, the school will not be liable for any loss or inconvenience suffered by parents and pupils as a result.

The Kura App

To complement the school bus service, Derby High subscribe to the Kura Transport app. The Kura app allows parents to track their child(ren)'s individual school routes, arrivals and departures, and view boarding and alighting updates in one place. If your child does not board, or if they alight at an unexpected stop, parents, the school, and the Kura teams will be notified. You can also cancel and book journeys in the app, giving you full control of your child's travel schedule.

The App offers real-time, accurate updates including traffic status, potential hazards, and delays, directly to your phone. Offering you peace of mind, the service is time-efficient and tailored to you. The technology powers the most advanced school runs in the UK, integrating tracking and communication for drivers, parents, and school staff. Your children swipe on and off with their own tag and the technology automatically notifies you in real-time.

Please do not download the app or register until you have received your invitation from Kura, as you will not be linked to your child unless you use the link provided. Invitation emails will arrive from welcome@ridekura.com . Please check your junk folder if you are expecting an invitation and it has not arrived.

Bookings

The school bus service is popular and some routes can get full quite quickly. We recommend booking a seat in advance as early as possible. Seats are available on a first come, first served basis. Bookings for the school bus should be made via the Kura app. To receive an invite for the app, please email buses@derbyhigh.derby.sch.uk and ask for a Kura app invitation.

Custom schedules can be booked via the app by selecting the desired dates/days of travel. Bookings can be made term by term or for the entire academic year. Please note, if booking termly, we cannot guarantee seat availability in subsequent terms. For yearly bookings, flexibility will be allowed for the GCSE and A' Level examination period. Amendments for Year 11 and Year 13 students sitting these exams will be permitted and not charged (providing amendments are made via the Kura app during the term preceding the examination period (spring term) and no later than the penultimate week of the Spring term). Journeys booked but not taken are non-refundable.

Passengers must use a Kura fob or a personalised digital QR code (depending on your preference) to scan on and off the bus. A passenger app is available for students to download if they wish. The app has all the features of the observer (parent) app but without the booking function. Please contact us if you would like your child to have access to the passenger app.

The cost of the school bus will be itemised on your school fee invoice, termly in advance. Please ensure you read the terms and conditions for using the transport service before making a booking. Terms and conditions are available on our website and via the Kura app. You will continue to be charged for the bus service unless cancelled in line with our cancellation policy. Please note we require a full term's notice in writing to withdraw from the bus service entirely.

Prices

Prices are based on the distance from school, incremental stop by stop, regardless of which of the six routes is used. There are 8 zones; zone 1 being up to 3 miles and zone 8 over 18 miles.
